“Putting the ability in disability”

Family & Caregiver Support Services

Special Education Assistance is offered to families that may need advocacy or additional support with the school.

Support Groups and Educational Workshops for parents of children with disabilities. This service is collaboration with local Mental Health and Mental Retardation centers and local school districts. Childcare and dinner are provided.

Parent Matches- Parents of children with developmental disabilities are matched with other parents where the children share similar needs. Parents Matches provide one-on-one emotional support and share useful resources.

Respite Services are provided in Travis County on the second Saturday of each month and in Williamson County on the third Saturday of each month. Respite serves ages 3-22.

Guardianship assistance is provided to families and caregivers in Travis County.

Arc Art Class gives clients an opportunity to socialize and participate in the community by meeting once a month to create different artistic and therapeutic projects.

Juvenile Justice Services

Juvenile Justice Services serves students ages 10-17 who are involved in the criminal justice system or are at risk. Staff provides case management and may attend ARDs and court hearings. Goals of the program are to prevent initial involvement in the justice system or prevent re-offense. This program has a 90 percent success rate.

Case Management

Case Management is offered to adults with developmental disabilities, in addition to individuals receiving Community Living Assistance & Support Services (CLASS).
